### Number of babies that graduated

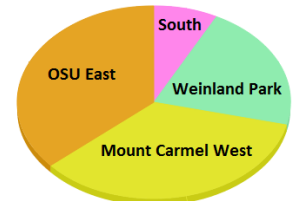
- 8 of our babies celebrated their first birthday this month!

  - 139 at OSU East

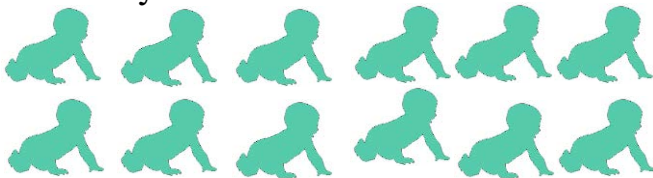

During the month of July, 8 out of 12 moms (66.7%) delivered at greater than 37 weeks!!

All 4 of the moms who delivered early are home with their babies and doing well.

We still have more work to do!

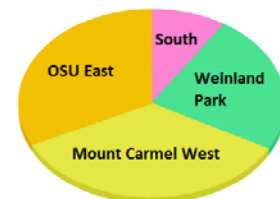
### Number of babies that graduated
